

Kingwood Chorale Rehearsal Guidelines

Please come to rehearsal with all of your music and a pencil. Be sure to mark your music with the printed notes the director provides as well as the verbal notes he gives in rehearsal.

Turn off cell phone ringers, and refrain from texting, emailing, checking phone messages, etc. while we are rehearsing. Those things can be taken care of during the break.

There should be no talking when the director is addressing the group. Also please listen when he is working with other sections as what he tells them will frequently apply to yours.

Get used to holding your music up and looking up from it as soon as possible.

Try to refrain from counting out loud, self-directing, foot tapping, head bobbing, etc. Those habits are easy to carry over into a performance.

Please do not sing along with other parts unless you've been asked to by the director.

Some in the group are sensitive to strong fragrances. They would appreciate your limiting the use of perfumes, etc. at rehearsals.

Do your best to work out your problem spots in the music outside of rehearsals. If you're still having trouble, let your section leader know so those can be addressed in rehearsal.

Notify your section leader if you are going to be absent. Credit students please do this even if the director knows you'll be absent.
